25th International Drama / Theatre in Education Conference 2024 March 22nd to 27th, 2024 at Retz, Lower Austria Dear members and sympathizers,

in addition to a brief report, this publication is also intended to give interested people a little more insight into the Drama in Education-Conference 2024. Of course, nothing can replace personal participation. However, we want to convey a little of the content and the atmosphere - and explain why the conferences have been so successful in recent years.

The conference in Retz 2024 was an anniversary event that focused with theoretical and practical aspects of drama / theater in education. For 50 years there have been events in Austria dealing with "Method Drama". The participants were confronted with this year's topic in a variety of ways - SHARING & CARING Every Child Matters: The Place of Young People in the World. In doing so, we made clear reference to the challenges of the years after 2020 and to the UNESCO Sustainable Development Goals (1); the reference to practical experience was present, theoretical elements complemented the practical aspects - and vice versa. In our opinion, this feature is part of the success, as confirmed by the feedback we received.

The conference was aimed at drama and theatre teachers from Austria and Europe, from all pedagogical context. We were really pleased to welcome a total of 95 participants from four continents. The aim was to explore the topics from as many different perspectives as possible, in theory and practice.

(1) The 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which are an urgent call for action by all countries - developed and developing - in a global partnership. (look at sdgs.un.org/goals; September 2024)

As with all conferences that IDEA AUSTRIA is allowed to host, we also expected an intensive exchange between colleagues that would have a positive impact beyond the conference itself. In line with a motto coined by a theater teacher at the 2017 conference: "You come as a participant, you leave as a friend!" Fortunately, projects were planned this time and have meanwhile been launched.

CONTENT

The use of drama pedagogical methods in lessons of all ages, all school types and all subjects is the focus of our events and is our central concern. It has become clear in recent years that holistic methods are needed in order to rethink learning and to take social and personality-building educational steps. This theme was foreshadowed in the title and was pursued throughout the conference and beyond.

Since April 2024, teachers have been provided with comprehensive documentation via a data platform, so they have access to the whole content and exercises from all short and long workshops and the key content from the evening presentations. This ensures that teachers can easily follow up on the individual modules. Participants usually take notes or organize these notes in some other way. We believe that we are offering a special service here (included free of charge in the conference package). This is also rare - and therefore a unique characteristic.

In addition, a booklet / reader was created; it contains general thoughts on drama / theater pedagogy as well as statements from invited persons. It is not to be understood as a systematic review of the history of Drama in Education in Austria - but as an example.

We would also like to include some feedback data and thank you very much for your appreciation and exciting ideas for further development.

26th International Drama / Theatre in Education Conference 2026

PROGRAM

The anniversary was accompanied by a change in the structure of the program. In general, it was very important to us to allow the participating theater teachers to get to know each other quickly. A central focus for us is to enable sufficient communication in and beyond the workshops. This need influences planning and organization - such as the choice of the "right" venue.

With an extensive opening ceremony, the introduction of all participants and the day's guests and a twinkling review of aspects of the past years/decades, we were able to get the people talking to each other very quickly. The five short workshops that were offered in the afternoon made it possible to do things together - and were also an excellent occasion to create opportunities for discussion through togetherness. Last but not least, the conference started with a get-together dinner and a city tour ("night watchman") on Friday - invitated by IDEA AUSTRIA.

The 95 participants were offered a particularly wide range of content in the anniversary year. There were five workshops to choose from on Saturday afternoon; the sixth short workshop was offered at the end and once again stimulated the participants' enthusiasm for playing. The one-day workshops were reduced from four to three. This change was received very positively overall - and the majority of participants found the brief immersion in one aspect of the overall topic very exciting, not least because the day guests were able to get a taste of the conference atmosphere and take away some impressions. All in all, this concept can be described as a success.




EVALUATION






23. What do you think about the **combination between THEORY & PRACTICAL WORK?** (one star is lowest, 10 star is highest rating.)

INTERPRETATION

It is encouraging to see how drama and theater teachers from Austria and all over the world are interested in further developing their methods - they got into conversation with each other in and outside of the workshops. We have made every effort to provide a high-quality program, and we also see the expertise in informal exchange.

Positive feedback and exciting ideas for further development seem to be convincing. There is interest in another conference. The report, script and reader serve as a source for further work.

Theatre methods are already being used in the classroom - by committed theater teachers. Anyone familiar with these methods can understand the benefits for learners. A major step would be the (compulsory) inclusion of these methods in the primary school curriculum.

A LOOK INTO THE FUTURE

Attending a Drama in Education Conference live is a great pleasure and extremely enriching. But travel and accommodation costs are often difficult to afford. That is why we are organizing an online conference in March 2025 - current topics and content without high costs. However, we hope to be able to create a little of the atmosphere.

Preparations for 2025 will start in a few weeks; a call for papers will influence the program. Apart from a small administration fee, the conference will be free of charge. People from countries with low purchasing power will be able to participate, and the Online Conference can also be used to "get a taste" of the Conference atmosphere. We also will invite school practitioners and education experts.

We are also considering the organization of the biennial Drama / Theatre in Education Conference 2026. The long-term goal is to incorporate the methods of theater and drama pedagogy into the curriculum of teacher training, starting with the primary level.
